Change over day will take place on **Wednesday 10th July** and will be followed by **Open Doors**, immediately after school (until 4pm), during which time you will have the opportunity to come into school and visit your child's new classroom, meet their new Class Teacher and hear about what they have been doing during the day.

Your child will not need their book bag in school with them on Change over day.

Updated Attendance Information from Stockport

We have sent a letter out to update you about new rules concerning Education Penalty Notice fines, which the government has introduced. A number of changes will come into force on 19 August 2024.

The Education Penalty Notice system is used where 10 unauthorised absences have been recorded against a pupil in any three month period, for example a term time holiday.

The new rules are:

- The **first fine** will increase to £80 per parent per child if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days.
- If a second fine is then issued to the same parent for the same child within three years of the first fine it will be for £160.
- Subsequent offences no further fines can then be issued if two have already been issued to the same parent for the same child within the previous three years (starting with the date of the first fine); instead, the parent will be prosecuted by the Local Authority in the Magistrates' Court.
