Attendance

When starting school we shared the importance of good attendance and the adverse impact on both the child's education and welfare when their attendance drops off. To find out your child's attendance percentage, click the module in your MCAS app.

We have identified a small number of families who have low attendance or are late to school on a more regular basis. We will be monitoring this and will contact families who we have concerns about. Our pupil attendance is monitored by Stockport who can work with families to address any challenges.

Please ensure genuine illness is the only reason to keep your child off school and you should notify the school office before the school day starts. Should you need to book a medical appointment, please aim to do so out of school hours to minimise disruption.

Thank you to all families who continue to prioritise great attendance and punctuality to ensure their child gets the most out of their school day.
