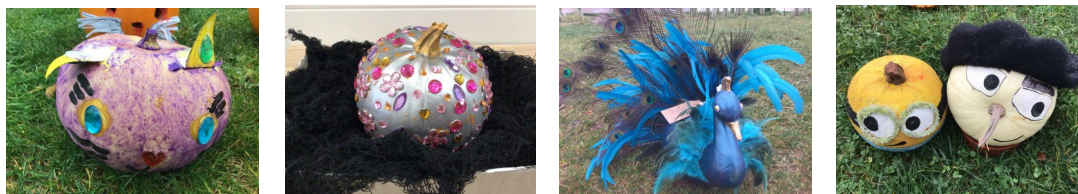
Dream big, fly high
