
Children's Mental Health Week 2025

Children's Mental Health Week 2025 has taken place this week. The week launched a decade ago in 2015 and it is celebrated every February, with this year marking the 11th Children's Mental Health Week. The week exists to empower, equip and give a voice to all children and young people in the UK.

This year, Children's Mental Health Week focussed on **Know Yourself, Grow Yourself**. We encouraged children to embrace self-awareness and explore what it means to them. 
